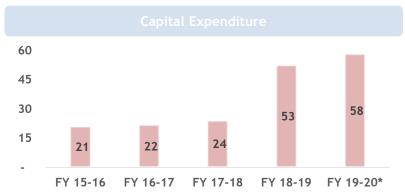
FINANCIAL METRICS for last 5 years - IN \$ MN in constant currency 1 USD @ INR 75.39
